Ranked 15th most corrupt country in the world.

- 61 years (males)
- 66 years (females)
- Top causes of death:
 - CVD
 - Diarrhea
- Neoplasms
- HIV/AIDs & TB
- Infant mortality rate: 52.2 per 1,000
- 7 Hospital beds per 10,000
