It is a privilege and honor to report to you the success of our first year's giving campaign for the University of Michigan Law School Fund.

\$49,663.61 was contributed by 1,199 alumni and friends of the Law School. Considering our late start in the year, and the necessity of setting up an organization from scratch, all of us should be pleased with the results.

In viewing the comments of our loyal workers, one of the most gratifying realizations was that few turned us down. The alumni who worked in the campaign are sure they can do even better next year. The enthusiasm to assist the Law School is

strong and in the years ahead will grow stronger.

I have noted with pleasure that the support has come from Maine to Honolulu, from Washington to Florida, and that alumni in Michigan have responded in strength. 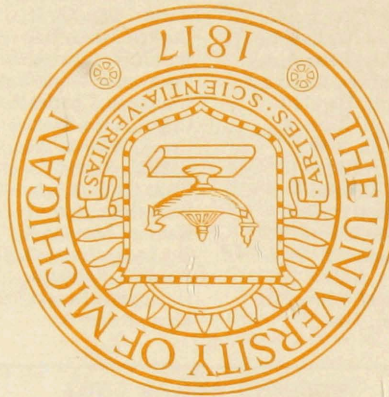
