

Reading... Between the Sheets



The cartoon and the caption may suggest to some that those involved with and responsible for the Law School Fund have found the key to an easy way of life, to rest and relaxation, to an existence without deadlines or worries, and that now that the Fund has achieved some success in past years its future is assured with but a modicum of effort. "Tain't so. I've been there and I know."

The plain fact is that a *LOT* of people put in a *LOT* of time and effort to make sure that the Fund continues to go and grow. A very substantial part of the work and planning that is required is contributed by the members of the National Committee and by the rest of the TEAM that volunteers each year in response to our "manpower letter" that reaches you in the spring or early summer.

The members of this TEAM have a variety of roles. As indicated, some constitute the National Committee, which meets at least once each year in Ann Arbor to review the preceding Fund campaign and to make plans for the next one. Some Committee members also take part in the "kick-off meeting" in the fall. The rest of the TEAM members fill positions as regional, state, or local chairpersons or as agents for their respective graduating classes. The names of more than 300 of the principal members of that TEAM for 1973 are listed elsewhere in this report, with either the summary of the year's activities by geographic areas or by class. Beyond this imposing list are several hundred other alumni—some known to us, but many others not even identified—who work as local solicitors. We've said it before, but we want once more to thank sin-

cerely each and every one of you—listed or unlisted, known or unknown—and to congratulate you for a job well done.

We cordially invite the rest of you to join the team, and to take part in the fund in 1974. We think you will find it exciting to be involved.

Of course we have an office staff in Ann Arbor to keep track of things, and to make sure that all logistical needs are available at the right time. But because this is truly an *alumni fund*, with labor volunteered as described above, we operate with a minimum force. A year ago in this column we reported that because of an increase in the size of the alumni body and the undertaking of some additional duties in the office, our "hand operation" was becoming difficult, and we would start "going on tape." We did—that is we've *started*—but you can take our word for it, this is a *complicated, frustrating, aggravating experience*. We are not dismayed, however, and we shall persist.

SUCCESS

The Fund had a *very good* year in 1973. The names of contributors and various totals are listed elsewhere in the report, and the graph that is included will show you the virtually steady growth of the Fund through the thirteen years since it started in 1961. But because you do not have previous figures for comparison you would not know (if we didn't tell you) that during the past year:

- (1) The Fund received more gifts than in any previous year,
- (2) From more donors than in any previous year (some donors do contribute more than once so the figures are not identical),
- (3) More *alumni* participated in 1973 than ever before, and
- (4) The *percentage* of participating alumni (perhaps the most critical statistic) inched over the 40 per cent mark for the second time in the past three years (and this in spite of a rapidly increasing *base number* resulting from large graduating classes in recent years and our considerable success in "finding" lost alumni).

THIS IS WONDERFUL! We are grateful that so many of you helped to make it so.

Still another statistic needs some at-

tention. We have indicated our concern in previous years about the number of alumni who become *LYBUNTS*—those who gave *Last Year BUT Not This*. There were 632 alumni (not counting those who died) that participated in 1972 who did not repeat in 1973. This was 116 less than in 1972, and the reduction, we suppose, can be considered a "success" for 1973, but it is obvious there is still room for substantial improvement.

COMPARISONS

Elsewhere in this report you will find a comparison by Regions for 1972 and 1973. This is impressive because it shows that the warmth and strength of our alumni and the support (financial and otherwise) that we have received from so many of you is broad-based. Virtually every region gained in either the number of gifts received in 1973 or in the dollars received, and many of them in both. This augurs well for the future.

Still another interesting comparison—not shown in a table—is the *change* in the *distribution of gifts* from the small to the large. The distribution as it was for 1973 is shown in the report. But the presentation does not show that in *each* of the five categories from \$25.00 to \$999.99 there were more gifts and more dollars received in 1973 than 1972. In each of the three categories from \$24.99 to less than \$10.00 there was a decrease in both the number of gifts received and the dollars received. This trend, with minor exceptions, has been taking place since 1969.

To try and point out specific areas or classes that showed the strongest gain is a risky business because of such wide differences in size, numbers and previous levels of participation but a few noteworthy accomplishments would surely include:

- (1) The number of "\$1,000 Cities" increased from 48 to 54.
- (2) Gifts were received from two of only three surviving members of the Class of 1899. Congratulations and warmest regards to these alumni who will celebrate during 1974 the diamond anniversary of their graduation from Law School.
- (3) Three classes already doing well did even better. Total dollars contributed by the Class of 1972 increased by 114 per cent; 1963 in-

The intangible evidence is the devoted and enthusiastic effort that so many of our loyal alumni all over the country contributed to help produce these numbers.

In a nutshell, the over-all results were these:

The small drop in dollars is disappointing but not disheartening; it is more than accounted for by one large special gift in 1972.

The best news is the increased rate of alumni participation. This is the single most important factor in the long-term success of the Fund.

I take pride not in the results, but in being part of the team and the building tradition that produced them. I look forward to another year as titular leader of this work to assure the margin of excellence with determination to improve the results.







creased by 106 per cent; and the increase by the Class of 1970 was a healthy 96 per cent.

(4) The total contributions from Region X (Wayne County, Michigan) increased 23 per cent and reached the highest total we have ever recorded for a single region.

(5) South Carolina *again* had a gift from every alumnus in the state.

(6) Several other states demonstrated a vigorous alumni body with substantial growth in both the number of gifts and total contributions; New Jersey had 49 per cent more gifts and 71 per cent greater contributions; Florida increased gifts 33 per cent and contributions 55 per cent; Minnesota's dollars were a whopping 129 per cent over 1972 and gifts were up 38 per cent; and Wisconsin showed an increase in dollars of 76 per cent with the number of gifts up 19 per cent.

Other results and the leaders in a variety of categories are listed throughout the report. Our congratulations to all of you.

NON-ALUMNI GIFTS

In 1973 the Fund received gifts totaling \$99,781.17 from non-alumni. Many are sent as memorial gifts (see details in another part of the report), and a substantial number are from companies and law firms with "matching gift" programs. A few other very substantial gifts come through charitable foundations and trusts where our alumni have a role in advising the directors or trustees; and from time to time we receive a gift from an alumnus' individual client who wishes to make a charitable contribution, and on the advice of the alumnus, considers the Law School Fund a worthy recipient. Perhaps you, too, represent a foundation, a trust, or other client that would appreciate knowing more about the Law School Fund.

BEQUESTS TO THE LAW SCHOOL

Some of these bequests provided new student scholarship or student loan funds, the others permitted the money to be used within the discretion of the Dean. These gifts are not reported with any other figures and statistics in the report because they were not the result of a donative intent in 1973, and because we thought the addition of the amount of the proceeds to the annual giving campaign would distort the direct results of that campaign.

In addition, the School received some unique and important papers and documents of the European War Crimes Commission from the Estate of Joseph V. Hodgson, '25, and a valuable volume of the Ethiopian Criminal Code from Mrs. Rollin W. Winslow. Mr. Winslow was 1920 Law.

These bequests serve as reminders of the truth and applicability of a statement published by one of our sister law schools to show the inter-relationship of its annual giving program and bequests to the school: "Annual giving to the Fund has improved steadily—but death terminates annual giving, and annual givers must become testators who remember the Law School in their wills."

Michigan Income Tax Credit

During 1973 we again were able to assure alumni whose income is subject to the Michigan Income Tax that their gifts to the LAW SCHOOL or LAW SCHOOL FUND, *not otherwise limited as to purpose*, "will be considered as being made to the General Fund of the University and, therefore, DO QUALIFY FOR THE LIMITED CREDIT PROVISION IN SECTION 260 OF THE MICHIGAN INCOME TAX STATUTE."

Without trying to get too technical here (obviously you will want to look at the statute) this meant (and means) that within the limitations of the Act the taxpayer can receive *credit* equal

to 50 per cent of the aggregate amount of charitable contributions made by him to the "general fund" of institutions of higher learning located within Michigan.

The basic limitations in the Act have been relaxed a little by Public Act 332 of 1972, which became effective January 1, 1973. The section still provides that the credit cannot exceed 20 per cent of what would otherwise have been the Michigan Income Tax or \$100, whichever is less for a single person, but now adds, "or in the case of a husband and wife filing a joint return as provided in section 311, \$200," assuming again this sum does not exceed 20 per cent of what would otherwise have been the tax.

There is little doubt that many of our alumni took advantage of this tax credit provision to increase their contribution (or in some cases to make their initial contribution) to the Law School Fund. Many more of you can do the same. Since these charitable gifts also qualify as deductions on your Federal returns (as contrasted to the Michigan *credit*) it means that many of you can make a substantial gift to the Fund, up to \$200 or to \$400 if you file a joint return, without a very large increase in your cash outlay.

Regardless of what you feel you can give, the happy fact is that for those of you subject to the Michigan Income Tax, you can increase the pleasure of your gift to the Law School Fund by the knowledge that you can "recover" a part of it through the Tax Credit allowance.

The favorable ruling from the Department of Treasury, upon which "assurance" was based, was predicated in large part on the fact that such contributions to the Law School Fund are directly under the control of the Regents of the University, and that budget procedures for the Law School Fund follow regular University channels. No ruling has been requested concerning the qualification of gifts to the Law School for specifically designated purposes such as class memorial funds, specified scholarship or loan accounts, etc. We expect that the designation of a particular fund or specific use for many gifts will continue, and we shall gratefully accept them. But the present ruling of the Department of Treasury, as given, applies only to gifts to the Law School Fund not otherwise limited as to purpose.

The Hundred Club

jective at this level is accepted by the donor(s) for successive years. A membership card is issued annually and special recognition is made in each *Honor Roll* edition. For those interested, Radrick Farms Golf Course in Ann Arbor is open to all Hundred Club members upon presentation of the

personal membership card and payment of green fees. The main purpose of The Hundred Club is to provide tangible evidence of strong University support and offer an incentive for others to follow. We would like to have you join with your gift to the Law School Fund.

The Presidents Club

The University of Michigan Presidents Club is one of the most respected organizations of its type in the country.

No other public university and few, if any, private universities or colleges have the allegiance and backing of such a large number of people who support their institution in one of the most effective ways—with dollars.

The Presidents Club has been enthusiastically supported by many Law School alumni, and a list of the Law members follows. Law membership increased from 173 to 189 in 1973.

How can you join?

You may be closer to eligibility than you are aware. All the gifts you have made to The University of Michigan since 1961, including of course, your gifts to the Law School Fund, are totaled as credit toward your membership.

Gifts of cash, or property or deferred gifts may be used to fund your membership through one of the following means:

(1) A gift in cash, securities, real property, or gifts-in-kind—totaling \$10,000 or more payable either immediately, at the rate of \$1,000 a year for ten years, or within and over the next ten years; or,

(2) A deferred gift of \$15,000 or more payable through a bequest, a Unitrust agreement paying you lifetime income, an insurance policy on the life of the donor (or spouse), a trust agreement, or any other deferred giving instrument acceptable to the University; or,

(3) A cash/bequest combination of \$5,000 outright or over ten years at a rate of \$500 annually, and a minimum bequest of \$7,500; or,

(4) A matching gift arrangement whereby a gift of \$7,500 by any individual is combined with a corporate matching gift of \$7,500.

Gifts to the University through the Presidents Club qualify as charitable contributions entitling a donor to federal income, gift, and estate tax deductions as appropriate to type, amount, and conditions of gift, age, and income of the donor, and state tax benefits where appropriate.

Gifts through the Presidents Club may be designated for the LAW


