**Huron Chase Administrative History to 2015**

Huron Chase was begun circa 1989, perhaps as legend has it, in partial response to closing an "Exmoor Cutoff" to prevent the proposed 'Clark Road Extension' from crossing Huron Parkway and penetrating Ann Arbor Hills as a parallel to Washtenaw. Over the years there have been folks from Ann Arbor Hills, Ives Woods, Barton Hills, and elsewhere who have lived here. Many are naturally associated with the University of Michigan; others are well-known members of the business community. A number have held volunteer positions with the City of Ann Arbor, on Boards, and so forth. The latter set is isolated here, in addition to Board members of Huron Chase, as there is some overlap in administration. Sandy Arlinghaus signed the final site plan for Huron Chase in 1999, for the City of Ann Arbor, in her capacity as a member of the City of Ann Arbor Planning Commission and its Executive Committee. The table below offers a simple summary; far more material is contained in linked documents.

Huron Chase Social Committee	Activities have included the following, with opportunity for residents to participate and get to know each other on almost a monthly basis (averaged out) for 13 years.: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Annual Block Party/Picnic, every year in the fall since the beginning of the development. One early party saw a hot dog stand brought in. Later parties focused on offering a full dinner of elegant dining. Huron Chase prepared the meat (Ricky Agranoff and Sandy Arlinghaus) while other residents supplied home made dishes to pass. One year, there was an outdoor Thanksgiving in celebration of being thankful for our wonderful neighbors. Other years, there were beef tenderloins (stuffed sometimes) whole pork loins, chicken satay, beautiful fresh salmon dishes, and devilled eggs and tea sandwiches (also provided by Huron Chase along with the meats) as well as the many creative efforts of residents who brought wonderful appetizers, salads, casseroles, and desserts! Typical attendance between 40 and 55 people; reports given to the Board. In bad weather, Jacquie also offered her garage. Substantial food offered: not to the extent of the block party, but enough for a light dinner--tea sandwiches, devilled eggs, fruit, veggies and dip, salty snacks. Residents bring their own drinks. Arlinghaus provided a new refrigerator in the garage for this purpose and also supplied professional banquet tables and a variety of other furniture. In addition to the social committee, numerous others offered furniture, advice, and physical labor: Pat Ross, Elmer and Barbara Hamel, Ricky Agranoff, Carolyn Conlin, Pierre St. Amour (who created a tent for us one year), Vivian Collier, Bruce Campbell, Alec and Judy Allan, Alma Lach (culinary advice and floral images). Again Arlinghaus condo (1964) was open to any who wished to go inside. Typical attendance between 50 and 70 total for a set of four parties held on four consecutive Friday afternoons (reports with specific breakdowns given to the Board); residents were encouraged to come to as many as they wished. The idea was that in a situation where multiple people co-own property it is important to get to know neighbors; if controversy arises, it becomes much easier to deal with among friends than among strangers. Also, there are more obvious security features associated with getting to know one's neighbors. 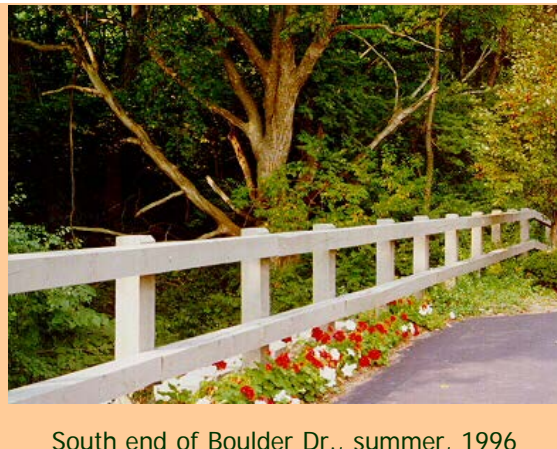
