





I am in receipt of a letter from Mrs. Helen G. Greenwood, Round Lake, New York, which reads as follows:

"My husband, 2nd Lt. Robert A. Greenwood was killed over Germany on May 12, 1944 and his death was reported January, 1945. He was a co-pilot of a B-17 and all the officers and one gunner were killed in the crash. His pilot's brother has located a grave in a small town near Frankfort, Germany, called Usingen-Taunus. From what information he could gather from the local civilians, Lts. Tuck and Greenwood were buried in a grave with four other men and he found the grave with a tombstone reading "Six American Airmen Who Died in the Service of their Country - May They Rest in Peace". I am wondering what the Government does in cases like this where the bodies of the boys are buried in the countryside. Are the bodies placed in an American Cemetary over there or what? 
