- 1 Fabric of soil is the shape and arrangement of units of the soil, such as mineral and organic particles & aggregates of these. Pedorelict fabric may be inherited from paleosols, parent materials. (Brewer & Sleeman, Brewer, Journ. of SoilSct., Vol.11,#1 and #2,1960).
- 2 Soil plasma particles are clay & & other colloidal particles,& relatively soluble matter which can be or have been "moved,reorganized,&/or concentrated by the processes of soil formation." (<u>ibid</u>.)
- 3 <u>Skeleton grains</u> of soil are those particles(clay to boulders in size),"and also resistant siliceous & organic bodies larger than colloidal size," which are "relatively stable & not readily translocated, concentrated or reorganized." (after Brewer)
