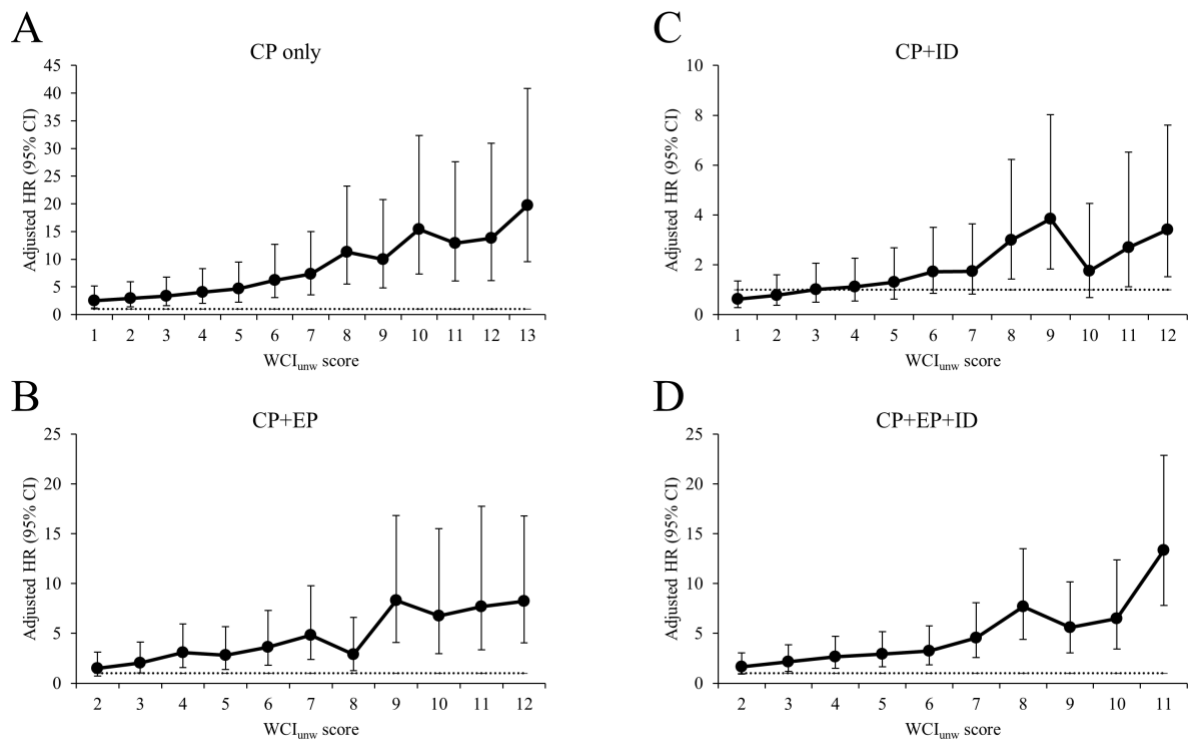

Line graph shows the adjusted hazard ratio (hazard ratio; filled circle) with 95% confidence intervals (CI; vertical bars) for each of the unweighted Whitney Comorbidity Index (WCI_{unw}) values with 2-year mortality as the outcome for (A) adults with cerebral palsy only (CP only) ($n=7,542$), (B) adults with CP and co-occurring epilepsy (CP+EP) ($n=2,607$), (C) adults with CP and co-occurring intellectual disabilities (CP+ID) ($n=2,781$), and (D) adults with CP and co-occurring EP and ID (CP+EP+ID) ($n=3,798$).
