

Book Review

Remote Sensing Data Processing, (J. L. Van Genderen and W. G. Collins, Eds.); published by the University of Sheffield, 1975.

This 142 page paperback publication is a collection of seven short papers by different authors on selected subjects of remote sensing data processing. It is intended to be a companion publication to *Fundamentals of Remote Sensing*.

The treatment of the complex subject matter is necessarily cursory. Useful bibliographic references add to the value of the publication.

The paper on photographic materials failed to reference two very useful works on the subject—*Photographic Considerations for Aerospace*, G. C. Brock et al., ITEK Corporation, Lexington, MA (1965), and *Photographic Systems for Engineers*, F. M. Brown et al. (Eds.), Society of Photographic Engineers, Washington, DC (1966).

The papers dealing with automatic data processing are well written introductions to the subject. A few good illustrations and an extensive bibliography make the publication a good beginning point for further study.
