On the cover: U-M Information Services Photographer Bob Kalmbach employed a "fish eye" lens in making this panoramic photo of the Law Quadrangle.

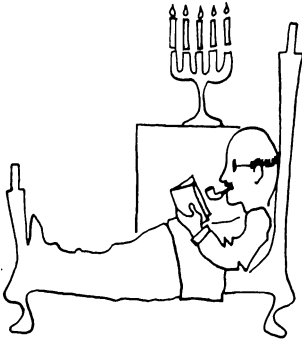

Reading... Between the Sheets



We always have a warm feeling when writing this summary of the Fund's activities for the past year because it is really a success story about a wonderful TEAM of hard-working, imaginative, and dedicated chairmen, solicitors, and class agents whose labors make the Law School Fund go and grow. This task also reminds us of the warmth and strength of our body of alumni and the support (financial and otherwise) we have received from so many of you. And certainly not least, it permits us to enjoy once more the very real help that the Law School has received from its many non-alumni friends during the past twelve months. Perhaps you will enjoy a few details.

Who

The principal members of this TEAM are listed elsewhere in this report, with either the summary of the year's activities by geographic areas or by class. If you look you will surely find the names of many of your friends. It may surprise you to know that more than 320 names are listed here. And beyond this imposing list of chairmen and class agents are several hundred other alumni—some known to us, but many not even identified—who work as local solicitors. The function of each is terribly important to the Fund's success. All-in-all we estimate that our TEAM is at least 600 strong. We've said it before, but we want once more to thank sincerely each and every one of you—listed or unlisted, known or unknown—and to congratulate you for a job well done.

Of course we have an office staff in Ann Arbor to keep track of things, and to make sure that all logistical needs are available at the right time and place. But because this is truly an *alumni fund*, with field labor volunteered as described above, we operate

with a minimum force. When the office is at "full-strength" we have three persons on hand, but we occasionally have "made do" with two. In addition, I provide general guidance as part of my duties as Director of Law School Development. Through the Fund's first twelve years we have had a "hand operation," with equipment no more sophisticated than electric typewriters, adding machines, and a postage meter, with access to an addressing machine for imprinting names on envelopes, gift cards, etc. Because of the rather rapid increase in the size of the alumni body, and the undertaking of some additional duties in the office, we are beginning the process of "going on tape." We shall try to avoid the mistake of going too far too fast, and to be ever mindful of the cornerstone of data processing: "GIGO—garbage in, garbage out."

Before we leave "WHO" we want to comment on those who gave during 1972. The names and numbers are listed in this report. But since you probably have no previous figures for comparison, you would not know (if I didn't tell you) that in 1972 we received the largest number of gifts from the largest number of donors in the Fund's history. Wonderful!

In spite of these records there were two troublesome statistics. Although more individuals contributed than ever before, the *percentage* of participating alumni dropped a fraction of one per cent, because with the recent large graduating classes, and because of considerable success in "finding" lost alumni, our *base number* has grown rapidly too. The other concern was an increase in 1972 of the number of LYBUNTS—those who gave *Last Year But Not This*. There were 748 alumni (not counting those who died) that participated in 1971 who did not repeat in 1972. We are not certain why this is so, but it represents a rather large portion of the previous year's contributors, and we hope we can substantially reduce this number in 1973.

Since YOU are the WHO, we cordially invite you to join into the fun in 1973 as a member of the team or as a donor—or both.

What

For the *twelfth year in a row* the Fund continued its steady growth. The graph, which appears elsewhere in this

report, dramatically shows this happy fact. Total dollars received in 1972 reached \$416,022.43—an increase of 14.4 per cent over the 1971 mark.

Total contributions to the Law School through the twelve years of the Law School Fund now exceed two and one-half million dollars—topping out at the end of the 1972 campaign at \$2,576,615.40.

Where

Michigan Law School has been a "national" and even "international" school since it first opened its doors in 1859, so it is not surprising that its alumni constitute a "national" and "international" body. One-third of you live in Michigan, and the rest live or practice in the other 49 states and various territories, possessions, and foreign countries. (We use your business address as often as we can for these statistics.) Every state and the District of Columbia have at least some Michigan-trained lawyers. Two (Ohio and Illinois) have more than 800, two more (California and New York) have more than 700, and three more (D.C., Pennsylvania, and Indiana) count more than 300 Michigan men and women. Mississippi has the smallest number—3 (but 2 of these regularly participate in the Fund).

Our point in calling these figures to your attention is to highlight the fact that support for the Fund is equally broad based. As you can see, for organizational purposes we divide the world into two basic parts—the United States and the rest of the world; and the United States we divide into fifteen regions. We are pleased to report an increase in either dollars or the number of gifts in all but three of those sixteen areas, and in five areas (Regions 2, 3, 13, 14, and Foreign) there was an increase in both figures.

To try and point out specific areas or classes that showed the strongest gain is a risky business because of such wide differences in size, numbers, and previous levels of participation, but a few noteworthy accomplishments would surely include:

- (1) New Hampshire and South Carolina *again* had a gift from every alumnus in the state. Keep up the good work!
- (2) Alaska, after a modest year in 1971, increased its participation from 50 per cent to 93.8 per cent.


This is, in fact, the twelfth successive year that the fund has done better than the year before—which is a fine tribute to the spirit of our Law School alumni.

Dear Tom:

Heartiest congratulations to you for finishing your two-year term as National Chairman of the Law School Fund with another record-breaking performance. The total amount contributed, \$416,022.43, and the total number of contributors, 4,284, both set new highs. The faculty and students of the Law School are deeply grateful to you, to the regional, state, and local chairmen, to the class agents, and to everyone else who had a hand in the 1972 campaign.

Professor Roy Proffitt, who has played such a vital role in the success of the Law School Fund, has promised to present a detailed story of the Fund's first dozen years in a future issue of *Law Quadrangle Notes*. For now, let me mention a few highlights.

The grand total collected exceeds 2 ½ million dollars—\$2,576,615.40, to be exact. Over half, approximately \$1,300,000, has gone to one form or other of student financial aid. Almost \$250,000 has been used to promote legal research, especially by augmenting secretarial services, and close to another \$100,000 has been used to supplement the Law Library's regular book purchases. Over \$150,000 was earmarked for an endowed chair. Air conditioning of certain classrooms and offices, the improvement of faculty, student, and staff lounges, partial renovation of the Lawyers Club, and miscellaneous construction work accounted for more than \$200,000. Office expenses incurred in operating the Fund were about \$280,000—a low eleven per cent of income.

The remaining \$300,000 or so covers moneys spent for a wide range of special projects, some to enhance the educational program of the Law School, and some to add a touch of graciousness to life at Michigan. These include closed circuit television, audio-visual equipment for the practice courtroom, faculty and student social activities, alumni surveys, and bringing distinguished visitors to the Law Quadrangle.

You have spoken most aptly on several occasions of the "margin of excellence" that sets Michigan apart from other law schools. I hope the figures I have cited give you and the other alumni and friends of the Law School some sense of just how much their generosity has meant in maintaining that margin of excellence.

(3) Total contributions in Region 14 increased 115.3 per cent; Region 11 increased 60.5 per cent; Region 2 increased 55 per cent; and Region 15 increased 39 per cent in 1972 over the 1971 figures.

(4) Georgia more than doubled both the numbers participating and total contributions in the past year.

(5) In 15 counties in western and northern lower part of Michigan, Elden Butzbaugh, Jr., serving his first year as chairman, increased the numbers contributing to the Fund by 175 per cent and the total dollars by 522 per cent. Can anyone top that?

(6) Two classes already doing well did even better. Total dollars contributed by the Class of 1930 increased 189 per cent; and the increase for the Class of 1949 was a healthy 66 per cent.

Other results and the leaders in a variety of categories are listed throughout the report. Our congratulations to you all.

Non-Alumni Gifts

In 1972 the Fund received gifts totaling \$93,457.25 from 169 non-alumni. Many are sent as memorial gifts (see details in another part of the report), and a substantial number are from companies with "matching gift" programs. A few other very substantial

gifts come through charitable foundations and trusts where our alumni have a role in advising the directors or trustees; and from time to time we receive a gift from an alumnus' individual client who wishes to make a charitable contribution, and on advice of the alumnus, considers the Law School Fund a worthy recipient. Perhaps, you, too, represent a foundation, a trust, or other client that would appreciate knowing more about the Law School Fund.

Bequests to the Law School

The Law School was the direct recipient of money in 1972 pursuant to bequests in the wills of four deceased alumni or their widows. These gifts are not reported with any other figures and statistics in the report because they were not the result of a donative intent in 1972, and because we thought the addition of the amount of the proceeds to the annual giving campaign would distort the direct results of that campaign. These bequests serve as reminders of the truth and applicability of a statement published by one of our sister law schools to show the inter-relationship of its annual giving program and bequests to the school: "Annual giving to the Fund has improved steadily—but death terminates annual giving, and annual givers must become testators who remember the Law School in their wills."

The Hundred Club

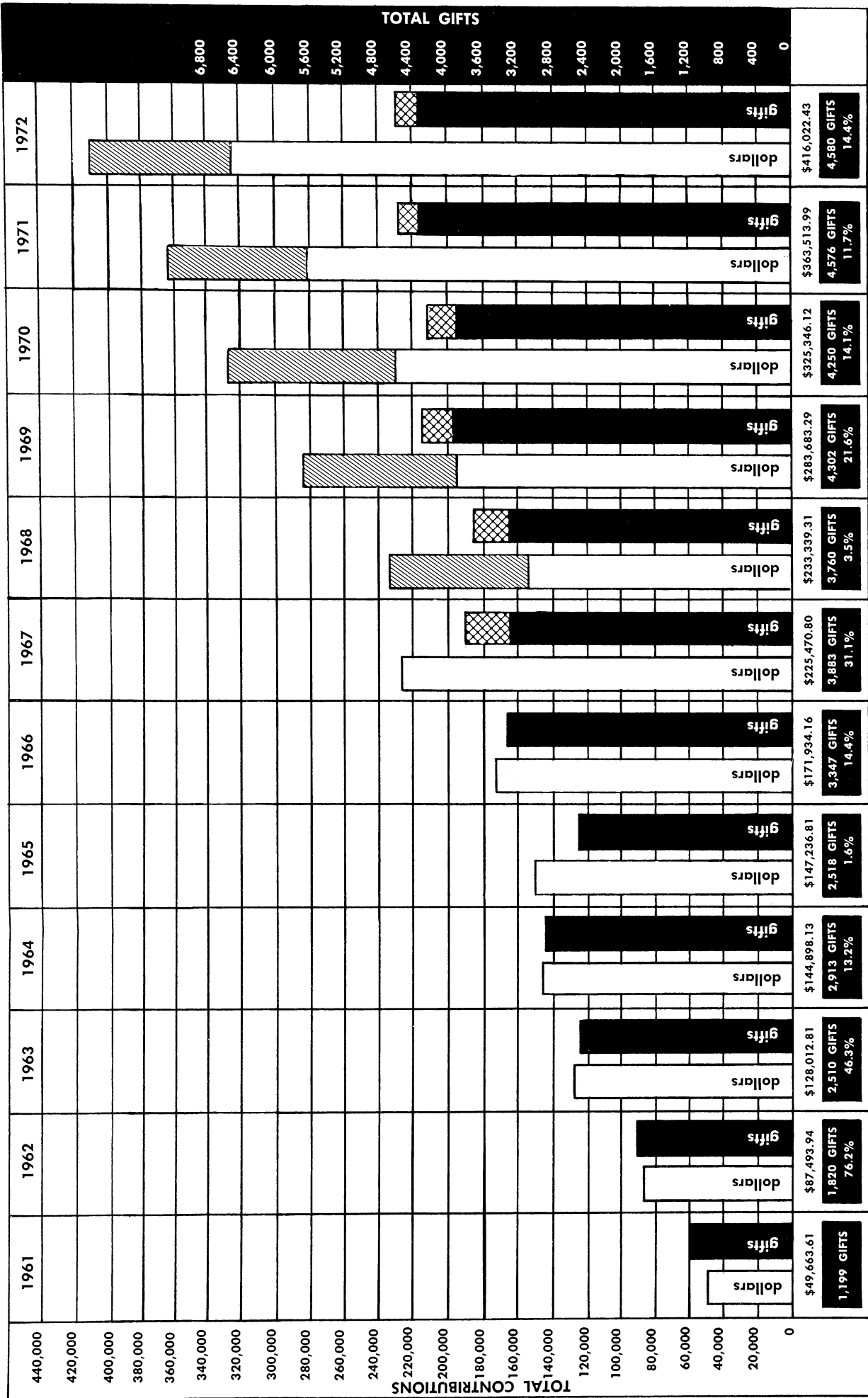

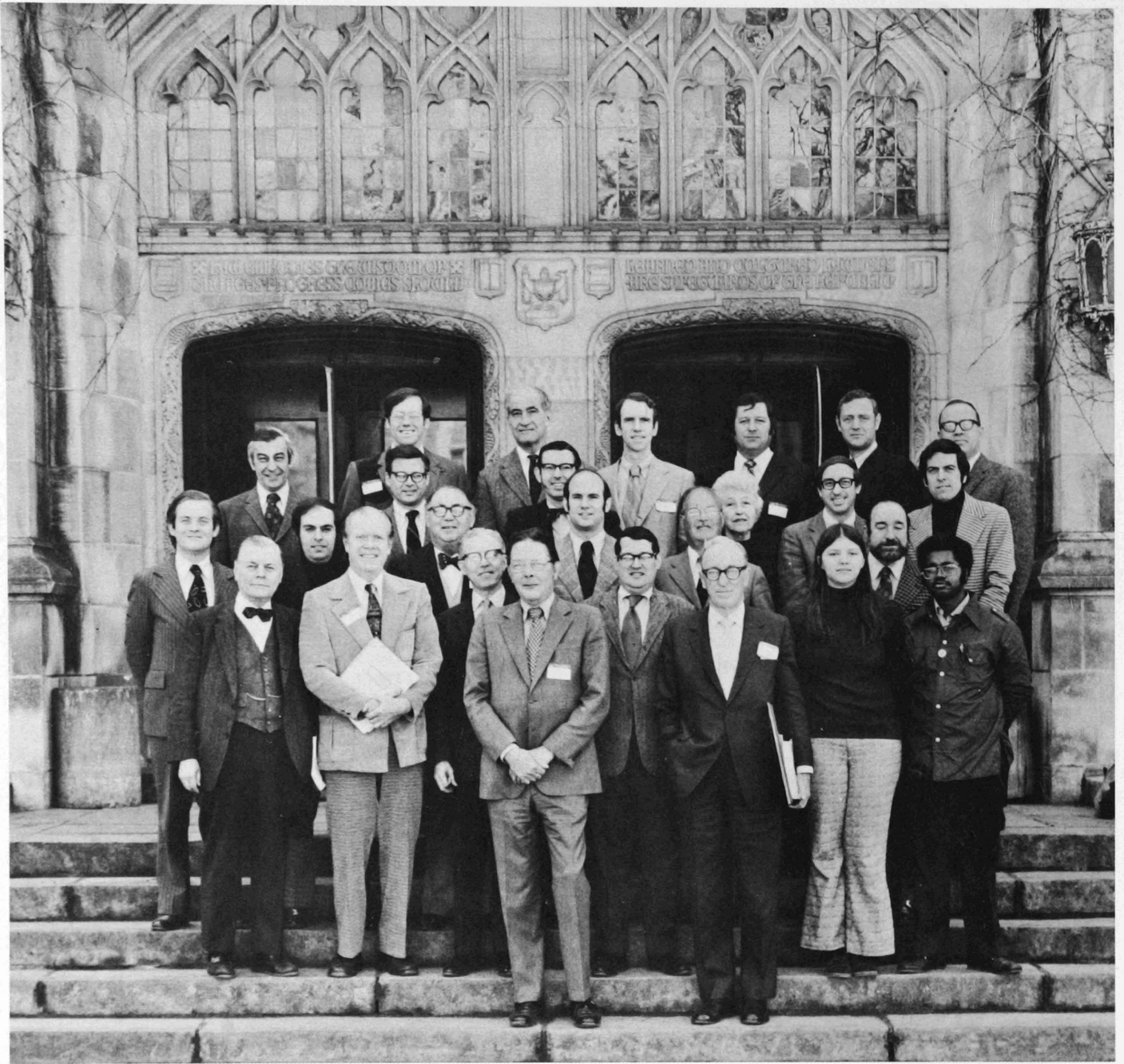

Michigan Income Tax Credit

During 1972 we again were able to assure alumni whose income is subject to the Michigan Income Tax that their gifts to the LAW SCHOOL or LAW SCHOOL FUND, *not otherwise limited as to purpose*, "will be considered as being made to the General Fund of the University and, therefore, DO QUALIFY FOR THE LIMITED CREDIT PROVISION IN SECTION 260 OF THE MICHIGAN INCOME TAX STATUTE."

Without trying to get too technical here (obviously you will want to look at the statute) this meant (and means) that within the limitations of the Act the taxpayer can receive *credit* equal to 50 per cent of the aggregate amount of charitable contributions made by him to the "general fund" of institutions of higher learning located within Michigan.

The basic limitations in the Act have been relaxed a little by Public

Act 332 of 1972, which became effective January 1, 1973. The section still provides that the credit cannot exceed 20 per cent of what would otherwise have been the Michigan Income Tax or \$100, whichever is less for a single person, but now adds, "or in the case of a husband and wife filing a joint return as provided in section 311, \$200," assuming again this sum does not exceed 20 per cent of what would otherwise have been the tax.

There is little doubt that many of our alumni took advantage of this tax credit provision to increase their contribution (or in some cases to make their initial contribution) to the Law School Fund. Many more of you can do the same. Since these charitable gifts also qualify as deductions on your Federal returns (as contrasted to the Michigan *credit*) it means that many of you can make a substantial gift to the Fund, up to a \$200 or to \$400 if you file a joint return, without a very large increase in your cash outlay.

Regardless of what you feel you can give, the happy fact is that for those of

you subject to the Michigan Income Tax, you can increase the pleasure of your gift to the Law School Fund by the knowledge that you can "recover" a part of it through the Tax Credit allowance.

The favorable ruling from the Department of Treasury, upon which "assurance" was based, was predicated in large part on the fact that such contributions to the Law School Fund are directly under the control of the Regents of the University, and that budget procedures for the Law School Fund follow regular University channels. No ruling has been requested concerning the qualification of gifts to the Law School for specifically designated purposes such as class memorial funds, specified scholarship or loan accounts, etc. We expect that the designation of a particular fund or specific use for many gifts will continue, and we shall gratefully accept them. But the present ruling of the Department of Treasury, as given, applies only to gifts to the Law School Fund not otherwise limited as to purpose.

The Presidents Club

The University of Michigan Presidents Club is one of the most respected organizations of its type in the country.

No other public university and few, if any, private universities or colleges have the allegiance and backing of such a large number of people who support their institution in one of the most effective ways—with dollars.

Presidents Club membership recently passed 1,264.

The Presidents Club has been enthusiastically supported by many Law School alumni, and a list of the Law members is printed elsewhere in this report. Law membership increased from 160 to 173 in 1972. The Chairman of the Executive Committee for 1973 is Alex Miller.

How can you join?

You may be closer to eligibility than you are aware. All the gifts you have made to The University of Michigan

since 1961, including of course, your gifts to the Law School Fund, are totaled as credit toward your membership.

Gifts of cash, or property or deferred gifts may be used to fund your membership through one of the following means:

(1) A gift in cash, securities, real property, or gifts-in-kind—totaling \$10,000 or more payable either immediately, at the rate of \$1,000 a year for ten years, or within and over the next ten years; or,

(2) A deferred gift of \$15,000 or more payable through a bequest, a Unitrust agreement paying you lifetime income, an insurance policy on the life of the donor (or spouse), a trust agreement, or any other deferred giving instrument acceptable to the University; or,

(3) A cash/bequest combination of \$5,000 outright or over ten years at

a rate of \$500 annually, and a minimum bequest of \$7,500; or,

(4) A matching gift arrangement whereby a gift of \$7,500 by any individual is combined with a corporate matching gift of \$7,500.

Gifts to the University through the Presidents Club qualify as charitable contributions entitling a donor to federal income, gift, and estate tax deductions as appropriate to type, amount, and conditions of gift, age, and income of the donor, and state tax benefits where appropriate.

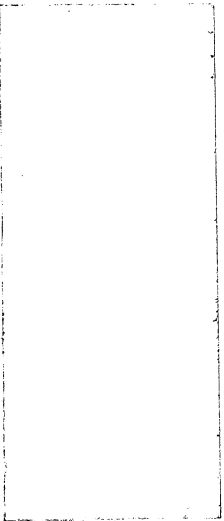
