

Resident Undergraduate Enrollment at UMAA

Freshman Enrollment	3,000	2,820	- 180
Total Undergraduate	16,000	15,500	- 500

During the past decade, we have experienced:

- i) a decline in the population of Michigan high school graduates of 15% (25,000 students)
- ii) a loss in State support of 15%
(which amounts to over\$35 million per year for UMAA)

Despite this, UMAA has managed to maintain its enrollment of Michigan resident students within 3% of the target.

In contrast, during this same period many other state universities have reduced their undergraduate enrollments of Michigan residents thousands of students. More specifically
