





The papers presented at each colloquium are published in a book that is sent to leaders of the world's best research universities and is available for purchase to the wider public. Most volumes have been published by ECONOMICA in Paris and distributed by the Brookings Institution in Washington D.C. The volumes are also available online some time after their publication.






