

How to interpret the files in this collection

All files included in this collection were created as part of the literature search and screening process for *Ethical and professional use of social media in surgery - A review of the literature*.

The files represent four types of content:

1. The complete, reproducible search strategies for all databases searched during the review
 - a. SocialMediaProfessionalismSearches.pdf
2. The collection of citations considered for inclusion in the review
 - a. SocialMediaProfessionalism.enlx
3. The citation import files for the Endnote library (.enlx)
 - a. Cochrane24Jan192017285.txt
 - b. Embase692Jan192017.txt
 - c. Ovid655Jan192017.cgi
4. The files associated with the screening process
 - a. EligibilityScreening.pdf
 - b. PRISMAFlowDiagram.pdf

Access to a program or software that reads PDF files is necessary to open some of the documents. Endnote is needed to interpret the .enlx, .ris, .txt, and .cgi files.

File descriptions

File name	Description
SocialMediaProfessionalismSearches.pdf	This file contains notes related to the literature search process, the databases searched, the date the searches were run, the search result numbers for each database, and the complete search strategies. To rerun the searches, paste the searches into the corresponding databases. Note that the results might differ because of the lapse between the date the searches were run and the present day.
SocialMediaProfessionalism.enlx	This is an Endnote X6 file that contains all citations collected through the literature searches. Duplicate citations were removed in this program and are not included in this file.

<p>PRISMAFlowDiagram.pdf</p>	<p>The Flow Diagram shows the number of citations excluded at each stage of the screening process.</p>
