#	Task	Description	Estimated duration
1	Interview/survey	You will be asked some survey questions that collect information on sex, age, identity, language, and religion.	5 minutes
2	Forced-choice preference Task	You will be asked to choose the better sentence among two sentences after hearing them.	15 minutes
3	Acceptability Judgment Task	You will be asked to rate sentences from 1 (least acceptable) to 7 (most acceptable) based on how you accept what you hear.	40 minutes

Your participation in this project is voluntary. Subsequent to your consent, you may refuse to participate in or withdraw from the study at any time without penalty. You may choose not to continue with the session for any reason. Should you complete this study, you will receive Php 300 in cash. It will only be awarded <u>after</u> this study has been completed. There will be <u>no partial redemption</u> of payment. This study should pose no risks to you.

When I analyze this survey, I will protect the confidentiality of your research records by removing any identifying information (i.e., names) from any materials, which will be archived in a secure location and a secure cloud storage (M+Box). The audio files and data will be stored indefinitely so that future potential work on documentation and further analyses may be done on them, with your consent. The data, once anonymized for names, will be made publicly available in audio and text form.
