<p><i>Partnership principles</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Advocate for and interface with institution-level infrastructure, including a support unit, externally-engaged professionals, and facilitators</li><li>• Embrace interinstitutional and inter-program collaboration</li><li>• Identify community partners, develop trust and reciprocal relationships, and implement partnership agreements</li><li>• Seek participation of administration/authorities outside the project (on both ends)</li></ul>
<p><i>Course Design principles</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Embrace service learning best practices in curriculum design</li><li>• Align project scope and student activities with curriculum</li><li>• Prepare students for international service-learning, including cultural and language preparation</li></ul>
<p><i>Partnership principles</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Adopt and coordinate organization, communication, and documentation strategies across stakeholders</li><li>• Implement a flexible, evidence-based design and management system</li><li>• Assign goals, determine objectives, and implement plans that align with each other and with stakeholder motivations</li><li>• Work within available material and human resources (at-home and in host community) on context-relevant challenges, solutions, and interventions</li><li>• Promote strong, consistent project leadership</li><li>• Recognize and appreciate culture and place</li></ul>
<p><i>Core principles</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Attend to diversity in project team and community (diverse voices, diverse backgrounds, gendered experiences)</li><li>• Emphasize team construction, team-building, and team capacity-building</li><li>• Employ interdisciplinary, critical, and stakeholder-driven project planning and evaluation</li><li>• Identify shared goals and promote ownership and commitment across stakeholders</li><li>• Prioritize sustained commitments, regular site visits and ongoing participation and dialogue with community</li></ul>
